

Impact Rules for Students

Have each Student read a copy of this document and sign the Student Contract located on the Student Information Form.

- Students are **not allowed off campus** during the week. No student is permitted to leave the IMPACT campus. All participants must remain on campus from the time of registration until checkout on Friday.
- Students are **not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle**. Vehicles need to be parked from time of check-in until time of checkout.
- **Late arrivals and/or early checkout are not permitted.** Students must attend ALL scheduled activities and school sessions. All participants are required to attend all school sessions, family group times, recreation, meals, and Worship Celebration worship services, beginning with registration on Monday through the final session on Friday morning. There are no exceptions unless you are with the nurse or the IMPACT office.
- Students must **follow the IMPACT schedule**. The IMPACT schedule is very demanding. No loitering outside the building before or after your class. Also, please observe all curfews and lights-out notices. There is no acceptable excuse.
- Students who are injured must be either in the IMPACT office or with the nurse. In the event of illness/ injury, you will not be permitted to stay in your dorm room. You must be in the care of the IMPACT nurse until you can return to your school.
- Students are not allowed to share any medication with any other IMPACT participant. All medications need to be listed on the Medical Waiver and given to the IMPACT nurse when you arrive on Monday.
- Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, fireworks are **NOT** allowed. Also, do not bring **CD players, IPODS, MP3 players, radios** (including clock radios), **computers**, or **other electronic games** (i.e. Playstation, Xbox, etc). Any electronic equipment will be confiscated until the end of the week should it be discovered by a TL.
- Students must **dress appropriately**. Casual clothing is acceptable during all IMPACT activities. Short skirts, short shorts, short dresses or low neckline blouses are not acceptable. Girls: please bring a modest one-piece bathing suit for swimming. **STUDENTS WHO WEAR CLOTHING THAT IS TOO SHORT OR TOO REVEALING WILL BE ASKED TO CHANGE!!**
- IMPACT participants must **wear their nametags** at all times. Your nametag is your meal ticket. Replacement fee for lost nametag is \$1.00.
- Students will receive key cards for their rooms. There is no deposit for these keys, but replacement cost for a **lost key is \$10.00** and must be paid **BEFORE** departure on Friday.
- Refrain from **ALL** public displays of affection with girlfriends or boyfriends.
- Under **NO** circumstances are girls to be in the guy's dorms or guys to be in the girl's dorms. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Students must obey the campus rules for the Georgia Baptist Conference Center. We are guests at their facility. Please be respectful of their staff and the other guests. We are a model of Christ to the campus.
