

Impact Rules for Team Leaders

Have each Team Leader read a copy of this document and sign the Team Leader contract located on the Team Leader Information Form.

- Team Leaders are **not allowed off campus** during the week of camp. If you have an emergency please contact the IMPACT Office.
- **Late arrivals and/or early checkout are not permitted.** Team Leaders must attend **ALL** scheduled activities and school sessions. All participants are required to attend all school sessions, family group times, recreation, meals, and Worship Celebration worship services, beginning with training on Sunday through the final session on Friday morning. There are no exceptions unless you are with the nurse or the IMPACT office.
 - **For Team Leaders**, this means you **MUST** attend training weekend. You may not be late or leave for a wedding, Sunday church service, etc.
If you cannot attend the entire training weekend, you cannot be a TL!
- Team Leaders are **not allowed to ride in or on any vehicle** during the week of camp. Vehicles need to be parked from time of check-in until time of checkout
- Team Leaders who are injured must be either in the IMPACT office or with the nurse. In the event of **illness/injury**, you will not be permitted to stay in your dorm room. You must be in the care of the IMPACT nurse until you can return to your school.
 - Team Leaders are **not allowed to share any medication** with any other IMPACT participant. All medications need to be listed on the Medical Waiver and given to the IMPACT nurse when you arrive on Monday.
 - Team Leaders must **follow the IMPACT schedule**. Remember, the schedule is very demanding. Please observe all curfews and lights-out notices. There is no acceptable excuse.
 - Drugs, alcohol, any form of tobacco, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, fireworks are **NOT** allowed. Also, do not bring **ipods, mp3 players, radios** (including clock radios), **computers**, or other **electronic games** (i.e. Playstation, Xbox, etc). Cell phones are only to be used in case of emergency.
 - Team Leaders must **dress appropriately**. Casual clothing is acceptable for IMPACT. Please avoid bringing short skirts, short shorts, short dresses or low neckline blouses. Ladies: please bring a modest one-piece bathing suit for swimming. **Anyone wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to change! TL's set the example!!!**
 - IMPACT participants must **wear their nametags** at all times. Your nametag is your meal ticket. Replacement fee for lost nametag is \$1.00.
 - Team Leaders will receive key cards for their rooms. There is no deposit for these keys, but **replacement cost for a lost key is \$10.00** and must be paid **BEFORE** departure on Friday.
 - Refrain from **ALL** public displays of affection with girlfriends or boyfriends. Remember, the week of IMPACT is about leading students to a deeper walk with Jesus Christ.
 - Ordering food to be delivered is forbidden.
 - Under **NO** circumstances are girls to be in the guy's dorms or guys to be in the girl's dorms. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
 - Team Leaders must obey the campus rules for the Georgia Baptist Conference Center. We are guests at their facility. Please be respectful of their staff and the other guests. We are a model of Christ to the campus.
