## **INVITATION COUNSELING GUIDE**

## 1. LOGISTICS

- · Importance of being on the same page.
- · Pay attention to the leadership of the speaker.
- Make your way forward as you see students responding even if they are not from your group.
- · When instructed, move with the students to the "counseling room."
- Match up with students.
  - M/M and F/F
  - One on One if possible
  - · With students from your group if possible
- Be flexible with the unexpected and assist if possible

## 2. COUNSELING PROCESS

- LISTEN Do not tell the student what their decision is, let them tell you.
  Patience is vital!
- AFFIRM Understand the importance of this moment in student's life and share in the joy.
- GUIDE Lead the student in understanding the "next steps."
  - · Encourage student to share decision with parents/pastor/etc
  - · Believer's Baptism
  - Personal quiet time: Bible study + Prayer
  - · Connect to local church
- PRAY Encourage the student to pray first, then pray for the student

## 3. IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Focus on Jesus He does the saving! (1 Cor 2:1-4)
- · Familiarize yourself with Personal Commitment Guide
- Smile and be personable. Allow the student to trust you.
- Allow the student to trust you, but never promise confidence.
- Know your limitations. Don't be afraid to ask for help.
- Write neatly and legibly on decision card. This permits follow-up.
